STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Repealing the Provision that Maine Military Servicemen are Subject to the Income Tax Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 36, § 5114, additional. Title 36 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 5114 to read as follows:

§ 5114. Residents in military service

Residents of Maine in the Armed Forces of the United States shall not be subject to the Maine Income Tax Law.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to exempt from the Income Tax Law those residents of Maine who are in the Armed Forces of the United States.
