HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 87, L. D. 127, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Rate of Contributions of Employees Under State Retirement System."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'R. S., T. 5, §1095, amended. The first sentence of section 1095 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes and the 2nd and 3rd sentences of section 1095 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 4 of chapter 415 of the public laws of 1969, are repealed and the following enacted in place thereof: Each member shall make a contribution in such an amount as the board of trustees, upon recommendation by the actuary, shall determine, provided said amount is not less than 5% of earnable compensation.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the original draft as to increasing the rate of a state employee's contribution.
