COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 66, L. D. 131, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Cheating by False Pretenses."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th underlined lines (4th, 5th, 6th and 7th in L. D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'If the signature to any check, draft or order is genuine and there is a fictitious account, and it is a single offense, it shall be punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or by imprisonment for not more than 11 months, or by both; and refusal of payment shall be prima facie evidence of cheating'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to increase the amount of fine and term of imprisonment.
