COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 67, L.D. 132, Bill, "AN ACT to Repeal Tax Exemption for Planting and Cultivating Forest Trees."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end, before the Statement of Fact, the following new section:

'Sec. 2. Exemption. This Act shall not apply to a landowner who, prior to January 1, 1971, has planted or has set apart land for the growth and production of forest trees under the repealed paragraph D, subsection 1, section 656, Title 36 of the Revised Statutes.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to exempt landowners who have planted forest trees prior to January 1, 1971.
