Resolve, Providing for Purchase of Copies of History of Three Corners.

History of Three Corners; purchase of copies. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$1,000 for the State to purchase 100 copies of the book entitled "A History of Three Corners" by Roger Storms, said books to be exchanged or distributed at the discretion of the State Librarian.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The book is a regional history of the towns located in the adjacent corners of Aroostook, Penobscot and Washington Counties. It has been the practice of the Legislature to encourage the publication of books dealing with the history of towns in Maine and thus preserving the history of the State.
