COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 91, L.D. 135, Bill, "AN ACT Creating Aroostook County Commissioner Districts."

Amend said Bill in section 1, in the 3rd paragraph of that part designated "§105-A", by inserting in the 2nd line (same in L.D.) after the underlined word "Caswell" the underlined abbreviation 'Plt.'; and by inserting in the 3rd line (2nd and 3rd line in L.D.) of said paragraph after the underlined word "Hamlin" the underlined abbreviation 'Plt.'

Further amend said Bill in section 1, in the 4th paragraph of that part designated "§105-A", by inserting in the 2nd line (same in L.D.) after the underlined word "Allagash" the underlined abbreviation 'Plt.'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out all of the last underlined paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Members of the board of commissioners shall be residents of the commissioner district for which they are elected and shall be elected at large by the qualified voters of the county.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 2. Transition. The transition to the Aroostook county district system shall be made in the following manner: In 1972 a commissioner resident in district 3 shall be elected

by the qualified electors of the county. In 1974 a commissioner resident in district one shall be elected by the qualified electors of the county. In 1976 a commissioner resident in district 2 shall be elected by the qualified electors of the county. Thereafter elections shall continue in a manner so that each district shall have on the board of commissioners a resident elected by the county at large.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 3.
