IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Conferring Degrees by Unity College.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Degrees. In addition to the rights, privileges and powers granted to Unity College by the private and special laws of 1967, chapter 102, and by the private and special laws of 1969, chapter 25, said Unity College, by appropriate action of its trustees, may confer upon all who shall satisfactorily complete such courses of study as said trustees may prescribe, within the scope customarily established by colleges offering 2-year curricula, the degrees of Associate in Art and Associate in Applied Science.

Sec. 2. Effective date. The first degrees to be awarded will be in June 1972.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to give 2-year students at Unity College credit for their efforts as well as a basis to complete the remaining 2 years for a regular 4-year degree.
