RESOLVE, Appropriating Funds for the Perambulation of the Maine - New Hampshire Boundary Line.

Appropriation; Perambulation of Maine-New Hampshide boundary line. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$7,000 to carry out the Revised Statutes, Title 23, chapter 13, subchapter X.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Funds were provided, by the 104th Maine Legislature, for the purpose of carrying out the above legislation; however, the funds lapsed as New Hampshire was unable to initiate the work necessary for the perambulation of the Maine - New Hampshire Boundary Line.

It is understood that similar legislation is being introduced in the New Hampshire Legislature.
