**AN ACT Relating to Open Season on Deer in the Town of Westport to
Conform with Lincoln County.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2353, amended. Section 2353 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding before the 3rd paragraph from the end the following new paragraph:

There shall be an open season on deer in the Town of Westport, and the islands within the confines of the Town of Westport, to conform with the open season on deer in Lincoln County. The use of any firearm other than a shotgun during such open season shall be unlawful.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to safeguard and protect the lives and property of the people by regulating the use of firearms within the Town of Westport during the open season on deer.
