STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Filing of Annual Reports by Public Utilities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 35, § 58, amended. The last sentence of section 58 of Title 35 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

Said commission may for good and sufficient cause extend said time for any public utility not exceeding one month and may, in its discretion, excuse any public utility from filing such returns when the gross revenue of such utility does not exceed the sum of \$4,000.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this legislation is to amend existing law which eliminates the requirements that certain very small utilities file annual reports with the Public Utilities Commission if that commission determines the filing to be unnecessary.
