STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Lascivious Speech or Behavior in Public Places.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 17, § 3758, repealed and replaced. Section 3758 of Title 17 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 20-A of chapter 590 of the public laws of 1969, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

§ 3758. Lascivious speech and behavior in public places

Whoever is lascivious in speech or behavior in any public place, upon conviction, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100 or by imprisonment for not more than 30 days, or by both.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to remove unconstitutional provisions of the present statute.
