**RESOLVE, to Provide Funds for Purchase of Aerial Ladder Fire Truck
for State Buildings.**

Aerial ladder; purchaser of. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$75,000 for the State to purchase a 100-foot aerial ladder fire truck for fire protection of state buildings in Augusta, said truck to be housed, maintained and operated by City of Augusta fire personnel without charge to the State.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this resolve is to permit the State to protect state buildings in Augusta from fire.
