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**RESOLVE, Reimbursing the Town of Greenbush for Loss of Taxes.**

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**Town of Greenbush reimbursed. Resolved:** That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$2,000 to be paid to the Town of Greenbush as reimbursement for loss of tax revenue on state-owned land and buildings for the years 1969 and 1970.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The State of Maine has taken property in the Town of Greenbush for a tree farm and the purpose of this bill is to reimburse the town for loss of tax revenue for the years 1969 and 1970.
