HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 170, L.D. 228, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Certain Penalties Under Fish and Game Laws."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of sections 14, 19, 31, 33 and 34; and by renumbering all sections to read consecutively.
