HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 170, L.D. 228, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Certain Penalties Under Fish and Game Laws."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of sections 14, 19,
31, 33 and 34; and by renumbering all sections to read con-
secutively.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is not to change the penalties
relating to game birds, hunting from aircraft, etc., aid to in-
jured persons, relating to beavers, mink and otter from what they
are under the present law.
