SENATE AMENDMENT " A" to H.P. 170, L.D. 228, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Certain Penalties Under Fish and Game Laws."

Amend said Bill in section 17 by striking out in the 5th
and 6th lines (4th and 5th lines in L.D.) the following: "~~\$200~~
\$300 ~~and-costs~~ nor more than ~~\$400~~ \$2,000" and inserting in place
thereof the following: '\$200 ~~and-costs~~ nor more than ~~\$400~~ \$1,000'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 29.


Further amend said Bill in section 32 by striking out in the
11th line (9th line in L.D.) the following: "~~\$20~~ \$50 nor more than
~~\$300~~ \$1,000" and inserting in place thereof the following: '\$20
nor more than ~~\$300~~ \$500'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 30 to 36 to
be sections 29 to 35.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to change the penalty for
night hunting and to change the general penalty for violation of
the inland fish and game laws.
