COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 176, L. D. 234, Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize Bond Issue in the Amount of \$5,940,000 for the Development and Improvement of State Park Facilities, Improvements to Various Airports, Equipment and Exhibits for Cultural Building, New State Office Building, and Maintenance Building at Augusta and State House Renovations."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and inserting in place thereof the following: 'AN ACT to Authorize Bond Issue in the Amount of \$3,090,000 for the Development and Improvement of State Park Facilities, Improvements to Various Airports and Maintenance Building at Augusta.'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out in the 6th line (5th line of L. D.) the figure "\$5,940,000" and inserting in place thereof the figure '\$3,090,000'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 6 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 6. Allocations from General Fund Bond Issue.

The amount listed after each project is to be construed as a quide and within departments or agencies any one or more amounts may be exceeded, with the approval of the Governor and Council, by transfer from one project to another but in no instance shall a project be reduced by more than 5% of the amount listed.'

Further amend said Bill in section 8 by striking out in the 7th and 8th lines (6th line of L. D.) the words "next regular or special state-wide election" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'primary election June 19, 1972'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the 2nd paragraph of section 8 and inserting in place thereof the following:

' "Shall An Act to Authorize Bond Issue in the Amount of \$3,090,000 for the Development and Improvement of State Park Facilities, Improvements to Various Airports and Maintenance Building at Augusta, as passed by the 105th Maine Legislature be approved?" '

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to authorize bond issue in the amount of \$3,090,000 for various improvements for Park & Recreation Commission, Aeronautics Commission and to Bureau of Public Improvements for Maintenance Building, at a reduced rate.
