# AN ACT to Increase the Salaries of the County Officers of Hancock County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 6th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

Hancock County: County commissioners,  $\$_{1,600}$  \$1,900; chairman,  $\$_{1,900}$  \$2,200; clerk of courts,  $\$_{4,750}$  \$5,250; deputy clerk of courts,  $\$_{3,100}$  \$4,100; county attorney, \$8,500; assistant county attorney, \$4,500; county treasurer,  $\$_{3,500}$  \$4,000; sheriff,  $\$_{5,700}$  \$6,500; register of deeds,  $\$_{4,750}$  \$5,250; judge of probate,  $\$_{4,750}$  \$5,250; register of probate,  $\$_{4,750}$  \$5,250.

### STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the purpose and intent of this legislation in accord with the desire of the County Commissioners of Hancock County to raise the salaries of the county commissioners by \$300, the deputy clerk of courts by \$1,000 and all others by \$500 excepting the sheriff whose salary should be raised by \$800 due to extra time required of his office.
