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**AN ACT Repealing Certain Procedure for Registration of Voters.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 21, § 102-A, repealed.** Section 102-A of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 154 of the public laws of 1965, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The 102nd Legislature enacted a law which would permit the registration of voters by completing an application containing the information desired and the application would be sworn to by a notary or a justice of the peace. The purpose of this bill is to repeal this law so that the applicant would have to appear before the registrar of voters.
