HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 204, L.D. 270, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Preserving Historical Materials by the State Museum."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by inserting after the first
paragraph of that part designated "§86-A." the following new
paragraph:

'Historical materials as described herein which are directly
connected with areas under the jurisdiction of the State Park and
Recreation Commission shall be exempt from this section.'

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to exempt from the
bill certain described historical materials directly connected
with areas under the jurisdiction of the State Park and Recreation
Commission.
