AN ACT Relating to Length of Certain Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 244, amended. The 4th paragraph from the end of section 244 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 54 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended to read as follows:

No motor vehicle, or combination of motor vehicle and trailer or semi-trailer, except fire department vehicles and disabled motor vehicles being towed to a repair facility, shall exceed in length ~~55~~ 57 feet overall including all structural parts thereof, permanent or temporary, and any load carried thereon or therein.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to help the citizens of the State of Maine to improve cargo transportation via trucks.
