RESOLVE, Providing a Minimum Service Retirement Allowance Under the State Retirement Law for William J. Davidson of Gardiner.

William J. Davidson of Gardiner; retirement allowance. Resolved: That notwithstanding any other provisions of law, William J. Davidson of Gardiner shall receive the minimum service allowance of \$80 per month as provided under the State Retirement Law.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The present law permits an \$80 per month minimum service allowance for those teachers with 10 years of service, excepting those whose service was prior to 1924. Mr. Davidson taught in Maine for 13 years between 1922 and 1937. The purpose of this bill is to correct the resulting inequity.
