STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Use of Power Boats on Long Pond, Oxford County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 38, § 245, additional. Title 38 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 245 to read as follows:

§ 245. Long Pond, Oxford County

No person, except officers empowered to enforce this subchapter, shall operate a motorboat having more than 10 horsepower on Long Lake, Town of Denmark, Oxford County.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to limit the horsepower of motorboats on Long Pond, Oxford County.
