COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 119, L. D. 298, Bill,
"AN ACT Providing for Adult Identification Cards under Liquor Law."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 6th line (4th line of L. D.) the underlined word "over"; and by inserting after the underlined words "years of age" the underlined words 'or over'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end of the 5th paragraph, before the period, the following:

'and shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$25 nor more than \$500, or by imprisonment for not less than 5 days nor more than 11 months, or by both'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide a penalty for violation of a misdemeanor.
