COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 219, L. D. 301, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Definition of Agricultural Societies to Qualify for Stipend."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the 4th and 5th underlined lines, after the enacting clause, (same in L. D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'The 3-year provision shall not apply to any society that leases or rents the premises or site for its annual exhibition or fair from any other person, firm, corporation or legal entity.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the State's position with regards to lease of fairgrounds.
