COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 228, L. D. 310, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Destruction of Vending Machines."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of that part designated
"§2507." and inserting in place thereof the following:

'§2507. Destruction of vending machines

Whoever willfully breaks, tampers with or removes any part
or parts of any vending machine or any other coin or currency
operated machine for the purpose of defacing or destroying such
machine shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500 or by
imprisonment for not more than 11 months, or by both.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to delete "injuries," add
phrase to insure inclusive wording and delete phrase connoting
conspiracy.
