AN ACT Relating to Destruction of Vending Machines.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 17, § 2507, additional. Title 17 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2507 to read as follows:

§ 2507. Destruction of vending machines

Whoever shall individually or in association with one or more others willfully breaks, injures, tampers with or removes any part or parts of any vending machine for the purpose of injuring, defacing or destroying such vending machine shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500 or by imprisonment for not more than 11 months, or by both.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The intent of this Act is to prevent malicious mischief to vending machines.
