**AN ACT Relating to Interest on Compensation Payable Under Workmen's
Compensation Law.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 39, § 72, additional. Title 39 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 72, to read as follows:

§ 72. Interest

Interest shall be charged on compensation payable under this Act at the rate of 10% per year from the time such compensation has been finally determined.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide interest on Workmen's Compensation cases when claims for compensation have been finalized.
