# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

## AN ACT Providing that Minimum Wages in Maine be the Same as Federal Standards.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 26, § 664, amended.** The first 2 sentences of section 664 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes, as last repealed and replaced by chapter 356 of the public laws of 1969, are repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

By reason of the declaration of policy set forth in section 661 and in the protection of the industry or business and in the enhancement of public interest, health, safety and welfare, it is declared unlawful for any employer to employ any employee except as otherwise provided in this subchapter at the rate of less than the federal minimum wage standards.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to set the minimum wages for Maine at the same rate as established by the federal law.
