STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Minimum Wages as Affected by the Average Weekly Wage in Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 26, § 664, amended. Section 664 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding after the 2nd sentence, the following new sentence:

Except that after the effective date of this Act, the minimum wages provided by this section shall be increased every 6 months by the same percentage that the average weekly wage in the State of Maine, as computed by the Employment Security Commission, increases.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to tie the minimum wage law to the average weekly wage in the State of Maine.
