**AN ACT Changing the Name of the Preachers' Aid Society of the Maine  
Conference of the Methodist Church.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. & S. L., 1923, c. 26, § 1, amended.** Section 1 of chapter 26 of the private and special laws of 1923, as amended by chapter 67 of the private and special laws of 1939, is further amended to read as follows:

**Sec. 1. Preachers' Aid Society of Maine Conference of M. Church, and Preachers' Aid Society of East Maine Annual Conference, M. Church, united; name.** The Preachers' Aid Society of the Maine Conference of the Methodist Episcopal Church, a corporation created by an Act of the Legislature approved January 26th, 1858, and the Preachers' Aid Society of the East Maine Annual Conference of the Methodist Episcopal Church, a corporation organized May 20th, 1858, under the general laws of the State of Maine, are hereby united and made one corporate body by the name of Preachers' Aid Society of the Maine Conference of the **United** Methodist Church.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This new name would conform to the changes already passed by the last Legislature as regards the name of the congregation.
