## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 105TH LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 194, L.D. 332, Bill, "AN ACT Providing for a Full-time County Attorney for Cumberland County."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and inserting in place thereof the following Title: 'AN ACT Providing for Full-time County Attorneys for Certain Counties.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 2. R. S., T. 30, §2, amended. That part of the 11th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes which relates to the county attorney of Penobscot County, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

full-time county attorney, \$8,000;

Further amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out in the 3rd line (2nd line in L.D.) the figure "\$14,000" and inserting in place thereof the figure '\$9,000'; and by striking out all of the last line and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Personal Services ---- (2) \$9,000'

Further amend said Bill by striking out the underlined abbreviation and figure "Sec. 2" and inserting in place thereof the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 3'
