COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 252, L. D. 334, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Payments by the State for Damage by Dogs and Wild Animals."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 6th line (same in L. D.) the underlined figure "\$400" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '\$500'; and by striking out in the 8th line (7th line in L. D.) the underlined figure "\$50" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '\$100'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to raise the amount of payment by the State for damage by dogs and wild animals to registered cattle and horses from \$400 to \$500 and for registered sheep, goats or swine from \$50 to \$100.
