STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Membership on Maine Real Estate Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 32, § 4051, amended. The first sentence of section 4051 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

The Maine Real Estate Commission, as heretofore established and in this chapter called the "commission," shall consist of 3 persons appointed by the Governor, each of whom shall be a resident of the State and who, immediately prior to the date of his appointment, shall have been a resident of the State for 5 years and 2 whose vocation for a period of at least 10 years shall have been that of a real estate broker or a real estate salesman and one who does not hold an unexpired real estate broker's license or an unexpired real estate salesman's license.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide that the public shall be represented on the Maine Real Estate Commission.
