AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Certain County Officers of Washington County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 16th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

Washington County: County commissioners, \$1,800; chairman, \$2,100; clerk of courts, ~~\$4,700~~ \$5,200; county attorney, \$8,500; assistant county attorney, \$4,500; county treasurer, ~~\$4,200~~ \$4,500; sheriff, \$5,750 ~~\$6,250~~; register of deeds, ~~\$4,700~~ \$5,200; judge of probate, ~~\$5,200~~ \$5,700; register of probate, ~~\$4,700~~ \$5,200.

The intent of this legislation is to effect salary increases as determined by the county commissioners of Washington County.
