STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Eliminate the Waiting Period for Eligibility under Unemployment Compensation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 26, § 1192, sub-§ 4, repealed. Subsection 4 of section 1192 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 409 of the public laws of 1965, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The intent of this legislation is to make certain that no unnecessary delay in receiving unemployment benefits is experienced by the insured.
