SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 270, L. D. 359, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to the Control of Dogs."

Amend said bill by striking out in the first line of the amending clause of section 1 (same in L.D.) the underlined figure "3457" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '3453'

Further amend said bill by striking out in the 3rd line of the amending clause of section 1 (2nd line in L.D.) the figure "3457" and inserting in place thereof the figure '3458'

Further amend said bill by striking out in the 4th line of that part designated "§ 3457." of section 1 (same in L.D.) the underlined words and figures "less than \$25 nor"

Further amend said bill by inserting before section 2 (same in L.D.) the following:

'§ 3458. Municipal ordinances

Nothing in this chapter shall be construed to deny any municipality the right or power to enact or enforce any law regulating dogs in such municipality.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to control and regulate dogs so that such animals may not be permitted to indiscriminately run at large.
