SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 278, L. D. 367, Bill,  
"AN ACT Appropriating Funds for Overtime in State Employment and  
Establishing Hours for a Work Day and a Work Week for Certain  
Employees."

Amend said bill by striking out all of the title and inserting  
in place thereof the following: 'AN ACT Establishing Hours for a  
Basic Work Week for Certain State Employees.'

Further amend said bill by striking out everything after the  
enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 1. Basic work week. There shall be a basic work week  
of 40 hours per week for all employees now working in excess of  
40 hours per week.

Sec. 2. Computation. In order to promulgate the following  
provisions, the Director of Personnel will compute the regular  
hourly rate of salary workers and those paid on an hourly basis,  
by dividing the employees' regular salary by 40 in order to  
circumvent any reduction in salary.

Sec. 3. Utilization by other funds. Wages of employees in  
departments supported by the general highway funds, special  
revenue funds, or other funds shall not be adjusted from moneys  
provided for the General Fund Pay Plan, but shall be adjusted  
from funds available to the department from other sources.'

The purpose of this amendment is to eliminate overtime funds
