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**AN ACT Increasing Tax on Commercial Fertilizers**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 36, § 444I, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 444I of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

With the filing of said statement, each such person, firm or corporation shall pay to the State Tax Assessor a fee of ~~4¢~~ 10¢ a ton of 2,000 pounds for mixed fertilizer so sold.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase revenue for carrying out the Revised Statutes, Title 7, sections 74I to 750, which includes the cost of inspection, sampling and analysis of commercial fertilizers.
