HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 283, L. D. 372, Resolve,  
Designating Part of Route 219 as a State Highway.

Amend said resolve in the title by inserting at the end  
before the period the following words and figure 'and Route  
179 as a State Highway'

Further amend said resolve by striking out the period  
before the statement of fact and inserting the punctuation and  
words '; and be it further

Resolved: That the State Highway Commission is authorized  
and directed to designate Route 179 commencing at Ellsworth  
Falls, Hancock County and extending to the junction of Route 9  
in Aurora, Hancock County, as a state highway.'
