STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Extension of Time for Operation of Certain Wastewater Treatment Plants without a Certified Operator.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 32, § 4181, amended. The last sentence of section 4181 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 237 of the public laws of 1969, is amended to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person to perform the duties of an operator, as defined, without being duly certified under this chapter, with the exception that the commissilon may grant an extension of this time up to one year for the operation of a wastewater treatment plant serving 1,000 persons or less without a certified operator.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit the Environmental Improvement Commission to grant an extension of time to certain wastewater treatment plants without a certified operator.
