STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Make Allocations from Bond Issue for Construction, Planning and Equipment of Pollution Abatement Facilities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Allocation. From the proceeds of the sale of bonds for planning, construction and equipment of pollution abatement facilities, from July 1, 1971 to June 30, 1972 and from July 1, 1972 to June 30, 1973, there shall be segregated, apportioned and expended as designated in the following schedule:

1971-72 1972-73

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPROVEMENT COMMISSION

Municipal Sewerage All Other

Any unexpended balance shall not lapse, but shall be carried forward from year to year to be expended for the same purposes.

STATEMENT OF FACT

A bond issue in the amount of \$50,000,000 was voted by the people after enactment by the Legislature by chapter 181 of the private and special laws of 1969. The purpose of this bill is to make allocations from the proceeds of the bond issue.
