COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 289, L. D. 389, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Allocate Moneys for the Administrative Expenses of the  
State Liquor Commission for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1972  
and June 30, 1973."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting  
in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 1. Allocation of Liquor Commission Fund. In order to  
provide for the necessary expenses for operation and administration  
of the Maine State Liquor Commission, the following amounts, or as  
much as may be necessary, are allocated from the revenues derived  
from the operations of the commission:

All Other		<u>1,138,782</u>	<u>1,144,470</u>
		\$3,574,145	\$3,600,539

Amounting to \$3,574,145 for the fiscal year ending June 30,  
1972 and \$3,600,539 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1973.

Upon receipt of allotments duly approved by the Governor and  
Council based upon work programs submitted to the State Budget Officer,  
the State Controller shall authorize expenditures from these allocations  
on the basis of such allotments and not otherwise.'
