STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Providing for Purchase of One Hundred Copies of History of Winslow.

History of Winslow; appropriation. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$1,000 for the State to purchase 100 copies of the book entitled "History of Winslow," published by the Historical Society of Winslow, said books to be exchanged or destributed at the discretion of the State Librarian.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It has been the practice of the Legislature to encourage the publication of books dealing with the history of towns in Maine and thus preserving the history of the State.
