AN ACT Increasing Payments to the Law Library of Aroostook County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 27, § 224, amended. The 3rd paragraph of section 224 of Title 27 of the Revised Statutes, which relates to Aroostook, is amended to read as follows:

Aroostook, \$4,300 \$5,200 of which \$3,200 \$4,100 shall be for the use and benefit of the county law library in the court house at Houlton in said county and \$1,100 shall be for the use and benefit of the county law library in the court house at Caribou in said county,

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the payments to the law library of Aroostook County from \$4,300 to \$5,200.
