AN ACT Relating to Conferring Degrees by Skowhegan Business School.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Degrees. In addition to the rights and privileges now held by Skowhegan Business School, said Skowhegan Business School, by appropriate action of its trustees, may prescribe, within the scope customarily established by colleges offering a 2-year curriculum in liberal arts, Associate of Arts Degrees and such honorary degrees, literary titles, honors and certificates of proficiency as are usually conferred by like institutions of higher learning.

Sec. 2. Effective date. The first degrees to be awarded will be in June, 1972.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The intent of this legislation is to permit Skowhegan Business School to confer an Associate of Arts Degree based on proficiency in a 2-year curriculum in liberal arts.
