AN ACT Regulating the Use of Power Boats on Lily Pond, Lincoln County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 38, § 247, additional. Title 38 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 247, to read as follows:

§ 247. Lily Pond; use of power boats

No person, except officers empowered to enforce this subchapter, shall operate a motorboat on Lily Pond, Edgecomb, Lincoln County.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to protect the tranquility and ecology of a small pond.
