STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Use of Motorboats on Ox Brook Lakes, Washington County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 38, § 242, repealed and replaced. Section 242 of Title 38 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 43 of the public laws of 1967, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

§ 242. —Ox Brook Lakes

No person, except a law enforcement officer, shall operate a motorboat powered by more than $5\frac{1}{2}$ horsepower on Upper and Lower Ox Brook Lakes in the Towns of T6 ND, T6R1 and Talmadge in the County of Washington.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to regulate motorboats on Ox Brook Lakes for better use of the area by guides to earn a living.
