**RESOLVE, Relating to Daily Bag Limit on Ponds Restricted to
Fly Fishing Only.**

Daily bag limit on ponds restricted; fly fishing only. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation establishing a daily bag limit of 5 fish in the aggregate for ponds which are restricted to fly fishing only.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to make uniform the daily bag limit for ponds restricted to fly fishing only.
