HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 299, L. D. 399, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Operation of Snowmobiles in Cemeteries."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 8th line (6th line of L. D.)
the underlined words "less than \$50 nor"

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end, before the
Statement of Fact, the following:

'This subsection shall not apply to any person who is licensed under
Title 32, chapter 21 by the Board of Funeral Service to engage in
the funeral service profession, in conducting his profession.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this bill is to eliminate the minimum penalty in
the bill and to exempt those persons engaged in the funeral service
profession.
